### Purchases made for the hospital

Over the past year we agreed to the following funding for the hospital:

In July '20 we agreed to funding of £2922.57 to convert a shower room into a store room on Anchor Ward In December 2020 we agreed £508.99 for a Nintendo

Switch and Games for Fletcher Ward

In January 2021 we agreed £883.99 for a Bariatric
Wheelchair for Podiatric Out Patients Department
In March 2021 we agreed £192 for a self propelled

**In May 2021** we agreed to £1236 for the purchase of benches to be placed outside MIU for patients to wait, these are still in the process of being sourced.

In June 2021 we agreed to the funding of £272 for the purchase of art materials and games for Fettle Rehabilitation Services.

In September 2021 we agreed to funding of £150 for the purchase of a vacuum cleaner and various cleaning materials for Bowman Ward for rehabilitation use.

Since April last year all these have been agreed through 'arms length' meetings via email, correspondence and telephone calls – we haven't yet aspired to Zoom meetings! We plan to return to face to face meetings next month following our AGM on 18th November 2021
